Key Vocabulary and Glossary

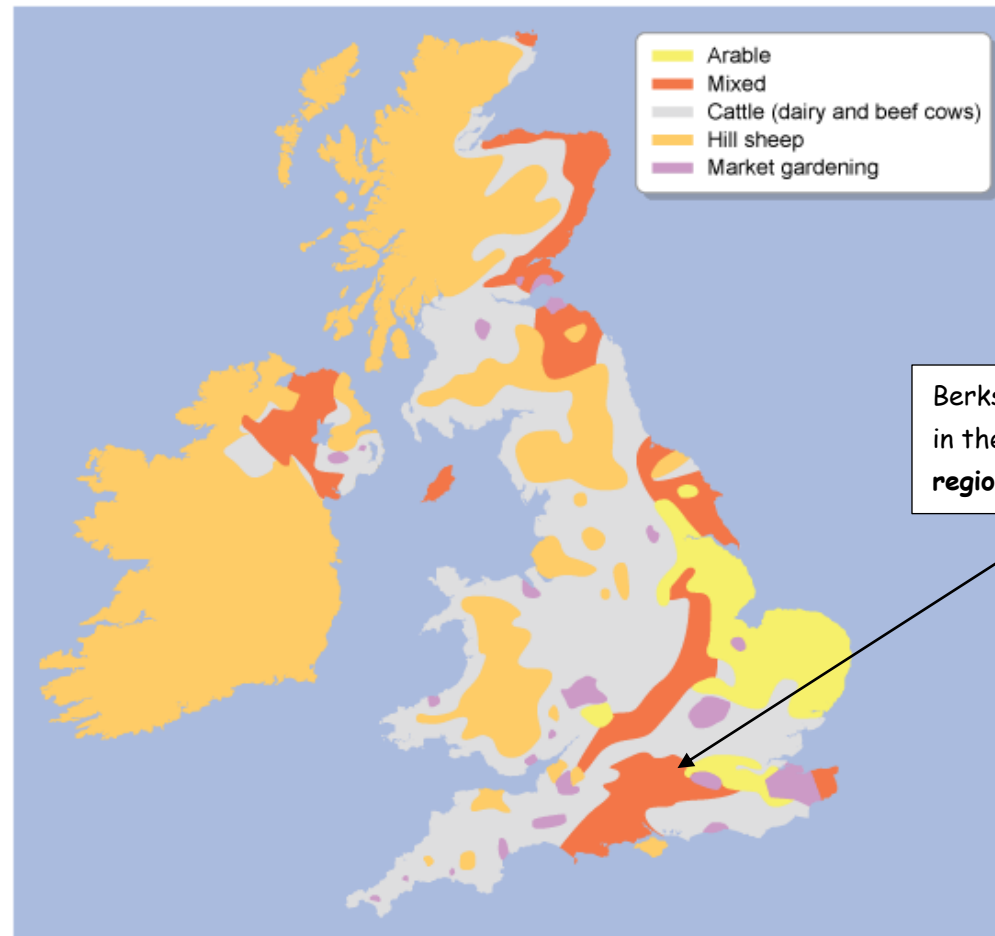
Word	Glossary
 agriculture	The science of farming. E.g. cultivating soil, rearing animals, and harvesting grown crops.
 temperate	Environments with moderate rainfall spread across the year.
 human geography	Human impact on geographical landscape. E.g. buildings, bridges and farms.
 county	A region which has its own local government.
 climate	The average measurement of temperature over the course of the year.
 ordnance survey map	Britain's mapping agency.
 consumer	A person who purchases goods and services.
 environment	The surroundings in which a person, animal or plant lives.

- Every map is accompanied by a legend or key.
- Commercial agriculture is farming for a profit.
- Temperate zones have wider temperature ranges throughout the year.
- Climate change is drastically impacting agriculture.

Key Knowledge

- Soils found in Berkshire: Sandy, loam, clay, silt, chalk, peat.
- Food miles is the distance food is transported from the time it is produced until it reaches the consumer.
